Registration Fees

A \$125.00 non-refundable registration payment must be turned in with the registration form and is due in the school office no later than Friday, January 31st for the 2025-2026 school year for current families. Registration form and payment are required to reserve a seat. Registration opens to the community for Kindergarten on Monday, February 3rd. This registration payment is **not** included in total tuition.

Tuition Plan

Actual cost per student is \$8,102.56

2025 - 2026 Tuition for Zion Members*: \$3650.00 2025 - 2026 Tuition for Community Members: \$4650.00

Tuition Fees may be paid in full at the time of registration or by August 15, or you may choose a monthly payment plan. (10 month plan: Aug-May; 12 month plan: June-May) Payments are due the first school day of each month.

Tuition assistance is available to those families *in need* of assistance with tuition for their children attending Zion Lutheran School. All requests for tuition assistance shall be made through the completion of a tuition assistance application form (available in the school office) which must be submitted to Zion's school administration. The application deadline for tuition assistance requests for the following school year shall be April 1st.

***Membership at Zion:** To be a "member" with regard to Zion Lutheran School (tuition) means that one or both parents and children are members of Zion Lutheran Church. You may become a member of Zion by transferring your membership to Zion from another congregation of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod (LCMS).

St. Mark Lutheran Church has entered into a cooperative educational relationship with Zion and members receive the member tuition rate. Sister LCMS congregations without an elementary school may enter into educational relationships to reduce the cost of tuition for their members. Each LCMS congregation is handled on a case-by case basis.
